Overview

“The Word of His Power” is the ongoing systematic expository Bible Study of *The Circle of Grace Fellowship*, led by **Rev. Steven Osazuwa**. This teaching journey through the book of Genesis reveals the divine foundation of all creation, the origin of humanity, and the eternal plan of God unveiled through His Word.

Each session explores the **depth of Scripture**, emphasizing spiritual formation, moral insight, and Christ-centered revelation.

Studies Completed So Far

Unit I: Creation and Commission (Genesis 1–2)

Lesson 1: In the Beginning – The God of Creation (Genesis 1:1–5)

- **Theme:** God’s Word as the Source of all things.
- **Insight:** Creation began not with matter but with the spoken Word of God — “And God said...”
- **Reflection:** Light was God’s first creation because illumination must precede formation.
- **Lesson:** Every believer’s new beginning starts when the light of God’s Word shines in the heart (2 Corinthians 4:6).

Lesson 2: The Order and Wisdom of Creation (Genesis 1:6–25)

- **Theme:** Divine structure precedes divine blessing.
- **Insight:** God established separation — light from darkness, waters above from waters beneath — before productivity began.
- **Lesson:** God blesses what He orders. A disordered life cannot carry divine fullness.
- **Cross Reference:** 1 Corinthians 14:40 – “Let all things be done decently and in order.”

Lesson 3: Man in God’s Image and Likeness (Genesis 1:26–31)

- **Theme:** Dominion through Divine Image.
- **Insight:** To be made in God’s image means to reflect His character, creativity, and authority.
- **Lesson:** Dominion is not dictatorship but stewardship under God.
- **Moral Application:** Our authority flows from alignment, not independence.
- **Cross Reference:** Psalm 8:4–6; Romans 8:29.

Lesson 4: Man Formed and Commissioned to Work (Genesis 2:4–17)

- **Theme:** The divine purpose of work and obedience.
- **Insight:** Before the fall, work was worship. Man was placed “to dress and keep” the garden — stewardship of divine trust.
- **Lesson:** God blesses diligence. Work done in obedience glorifies Him.
- **Moral Application:** We must labour from love, not survival.
- **Cross Reference:** Colossians 3:23.

Lesson 5: The Gift of Companionship (Genesis 2:18–25)

- **Theme:** Divine order in relationship and unity.
- **Insight:** God formed woman from man's side — not his head to rule over him, nor his feet to be trampled — but his side, for partnership.
- **Lesson:** True companionship reflects divine design, not human ambition.
- **Cross Reference:** Ecclesiastes 4:9–12; Ephesians 5:25–33.

Unit II: Fall, Judgment, and Mercy (Genesis 3–5)

Lesson 6: The Fall – Lies, Loss, and the Lament of Humanity (Genesis 3:1–13)

- **Theme:** The subtlety of deception and the tragedy of disobedience.
- **Insight:** The serpent's lie distorted God's truth, appealing to desire rather than obedience.
- **Lesson:** The greatest temptation is not to rebel, but to reason outside revelation.
- **Cross Reference:** 2 Corinthians 11:3; 1 John 2:16.

Lesson 7: The Fall's Impact – Eyes Opened, Hearts Darkened (Genesis 3:4–7)

- **Theme:** The illusion of enlightenment without God.
- **Insight:** Their eyes were opened, yet they saw shame. Knowledge without righteousness produces guilt, not growth.
- **Lesson:** Every sin promises wisdom but delivers emptiness.
- **Cross Reference:** Romans 1:21–22.

Lesson 8: Walking with God (Genesis 5:21–24)



- **Theme:** The fellowship that transcends mortality.
- **Insight:** Enoch's walk with God was continual, not casual. His intimacy with God made him unfit for corruption.
- **Lesson:** Walking with God requires consistency, purity, and pursuit of His presence.
- **Moral Application:** Your walk determines your witness.
- **Cross Reference:** Hebrews 11:5–6; Amos 3:3.

Current Focus

We are presently journeying through **Genesis 5**, examining **how faithfulness, obedience, and divine fellowship shape the destiny of men and nations.**
